









It is that time of the year when we are starting to finalise our **2015 Camps Programs**. Our camps this year are as follows:

It is nice to know that our students will have a familiar face at camp.

MPS Photography took our **2015 School Photos** last Tuesday. It was very noticeable that a number of variations to our **School Uniform** are appearing which are not compliant with our School Uniform Policy. The purpose of a school uniform is to have everyone look the same and to take pride in our school. Our Parents' Club operate our uniform shop making it accessible for parents. There is also a uniform order that is sent home each term.



Last term School Council endorsed our new Uniform Policy which was also sent home. I have attached another copy of this policy seeking your assistance in ensuring your child/ren are wearing correct school uniform. Your assistance is greatly appreciated.

Thank you to those families who have already returned our **Kialla Central P.S. Parent Feedback Survey (printed on orange paper)**. To date I have received 16 completed surveys out of 42 families who are at our school. Therefore, it would be pleasing to receive some more back by this coming **Friday 7th August**.



It is also pleasing to see 19 families have also returned the **Department of Education & Training's Parent Opinion Survey**. This year I am aiming for a minimum of 32 surveys to be returned so the data we collect is a true cross section of our parents' feedback and opinion. 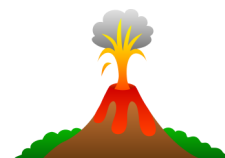

of Strathmerton PS). Although your child may be feeling quite comfortable with moving on to secondary school I still encourage you to attend as I'm sure you will definitely get a strategy that will benefit your child or yourself in the future. **RSVPs are compulsory** and need to be to me by **Friday 7th August**. Head lice are still creating an issue. I cannot stress enough that all families need to check, treat and take preventative measures to address this issue. The conditioner method only works if you actually comb your child's hair and physically remove the eggs with a **nit comb**. If you don't get rid of all the eggs then in 7 days another batch of louse hatch and it starts all over again. We are trying our best to combat this problem at school.
