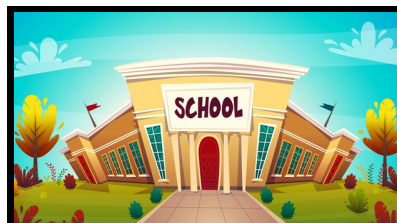

Hot lunch days on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Students are able to bring a lunch that can be heated up in our pie warmers.

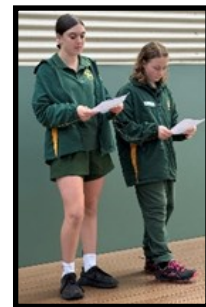
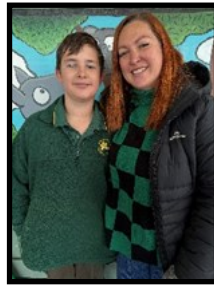
