





2025 K.C.P.S. Footy Tipping Competition Round 15 with Magic Magpies

Thursday 19th June

Challenged briefly by a weakened **Bomber** side, the **Dockers** flexed their muscle, winning every quarter, and prevailed in a fifth consecutive game win, for the first time since 2022, **16.8 (104)** to **9.9 (63)**. With significant injury issues, the **Bombers** were always going to struggle in the West, but they showed plenty of grit at different stages. They could not compete with the **Dockers**' midfield, however, losing clearances **(44-26)** and inside 50s **(57-34)** by large margins. Time to head north **Bomber 10** your beloved **Bombers** are done for 2025, enjoy the sunshine!

Friday 20th June

The **Danger Show**, quite rightly, rolled into G Town this week, celebrating a superstar's 350th game. But the **Lions** weren't interested in bringing a plate to the party, kicking the first four goals of the game to leave the **Cats** somewhat dazed and floundering after a week of **Patrick Dangerfield** festivities. The **Lions** found holes where few can across the narrow GMHBA

Stadium and picking their way through the **Cats** with ease to record a thumping **41-point** win **14.8** (**92**) to a very inaccurate **6.15** (**51**).

Saturday 21st June

The Michael Voss era is in major trouble after the **Blues** conceded eight straight goals against the **Kangas** to be stunned by **11-points** at the MCG. Just 64 days after smashing the **Kangas** by 82-points on Good Friday, the **Blues** went goalless from midway through the first quarter until the 10 minute mark of the third term. Sunday 22nd June

The **Giants** came back from the clouds to eclipse the **Suns** in a stunning comeback win. The **Giants** trailed at the last change but four goals in the opening 8 minutes helped them to snatch the lead for the first time in the game before holding off a gritty **Suns** challenge for a **16.10** (**106**) to **14.15** (**99**) win.

The **Bulldogs** have had a few issues beating the teams below them this season, and Sunday's easy **79-point** triumph over the **Tigers** always looked like it would be the exception. But tougher test await the Bulldogs, with their 1-6 record against top 8 teams remains the biggest question



This expression of interest is designed to determine how many of our families would consider using this program, based at Grahamvale P.S. Patsi works at this holiday program.


The **Expression of Interest Form** is available at the office or from Patsi. Families need to complete and return to Kialla Central P.S. by **Tuesday 10th June**.
