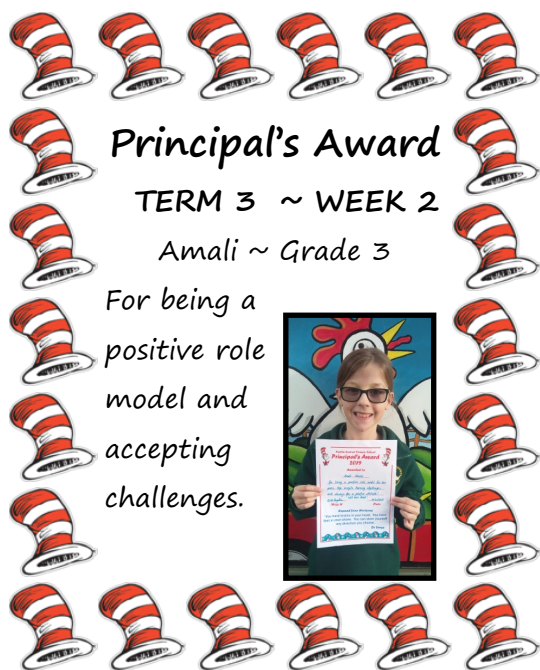

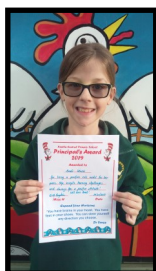

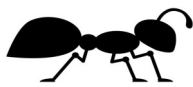
# CLASSROOM WRAP
