Information about our F/1/2 Camp

program has been sent home. This program is an important part of our Kialla Central Primary School Camps Program, as it helps to prepare students for our extended camp for Grade 3 to 6 students. Please ensure you have arrangements in place for your child/ren to be picked up from school on Friday 7th November at 1.30pm, as the F/1/2 students are not required at school in the afternoon. Permission notes are due back to school by Thursday 30th October.

School Council Update



School Council held its October meeting last Monday night. Some of the topics discussed included:

- Parent/Carers/Guardian Survey.

Overall our results were very positive which

reassures us that we are meeting the needs of our families as well as further refining the connection between school and home, and home and school. Thank you to our families who participated.

Condition Assessment Report

Schools receive a condition assessment report as part of their Rolling Facilities Evaluation (RFE), every 4 years. This report identifies defects at the school via a visual assessment, listed by priority. Planned maintenance program funding is allocated in response to the RFE, specifically for defects required to be addressed within the next 6 or 12 months (priority 1 and 2 respectively). This includes defects requiring further investigation by the Victorian Schools Building Authority. The next step is to develop a 5 year maintenance plan to rectify issues that have been identified in this report. Lisa Irwin, myself and a member from the VSBA will develop the plan which will then be presented at School Council.

Update on planning for 2026

I provided School Council with an update on proposed planning re grade structures, staffing and our indicative budget. I will be finalising this in the next couple of weeks and I will announce it to our families in our newsletter.

VSBA grant application

I applied for a grant for replacing our current playgrounds. We have progressed to being shortlist for funding. Successful projects will be announced at the end of November. Fingers crossed ...

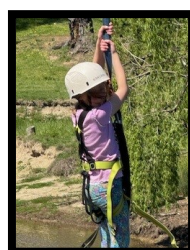

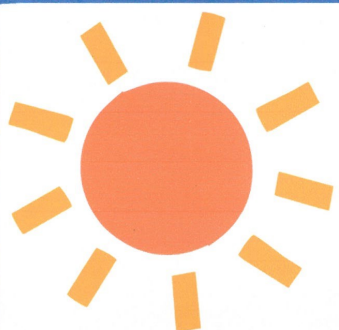
Welcome
