





has adjusted the expectations around student reporting for Semester 2 in recognition of the disruption caused by COVID-19. As a result, a modified written report focusing on what progress has been made and what has been achieved by each child will be sent home. A letter outlining this in greater detail will be included with the eldest student's report. Once again our teachers know their students extremely well and these reports reflect this knowledge by celebrating each students success and identifying areas they can improve in. Please note: there are no Parent/Teacher interviews in Semester 2 unless requested by your child's classroom teacher.

On Tuesday 14th December we are holding our end of year presentations and a family picnic in lieu of our usual concert. This event will take place at KidsTown from 5.30pm with presentation starting at 6.00pm. We have booked the area known as Peppercorn 2 & 3 which is the space as you cross the railway line. 


